

FOSTER HOME Application

The Oneida County Humane Society Adoption Center (OCHS-AC) is always in need of foster homes to care for pets until they are adopted. Volunteering to foster requires a commitment of time, love, patience and a desire to help abandoned and unwanted dogs and cats become properly socialized and find permanent, loving homes. It is also a financial commitment to provide appropriate food (puppy/dog/cat/kitten, dry/canned), exercise for dogs, fresh litter for cats, and a healthy, happy environment (warm bedding, toys, attention, etc).

Foster placements may be as short as a few days or a week, or as long as a few months, depending on the age and health of the foster animal and how soon they are adopted. If you prefer shorter or longer stays for your foster animals, or have any other special requests or questions, please let us know.

Applicants that currently have other pets <u>must</u> have a veterinary reference. All members of the prospective foster family must be present or spoken to by an OCHS-AC employee or volunteer either at the home visit or sometime before they pick up the foster animal. All applicants must live in Oneida County and be willing to transport the fostered pet to veterinary appointments and adoption days, if possible. (If a foster cannot transport an animal the OCHS-AC will try to accommodate and provide transportation.) If you rent, you must have written consent from your landlord and provide a copy of the lease agreement stating that you are allowed pets. The OCHS-AC will not allow an animal to be fostered if that person will be or already is over the number of animals allowed at the rental property.
